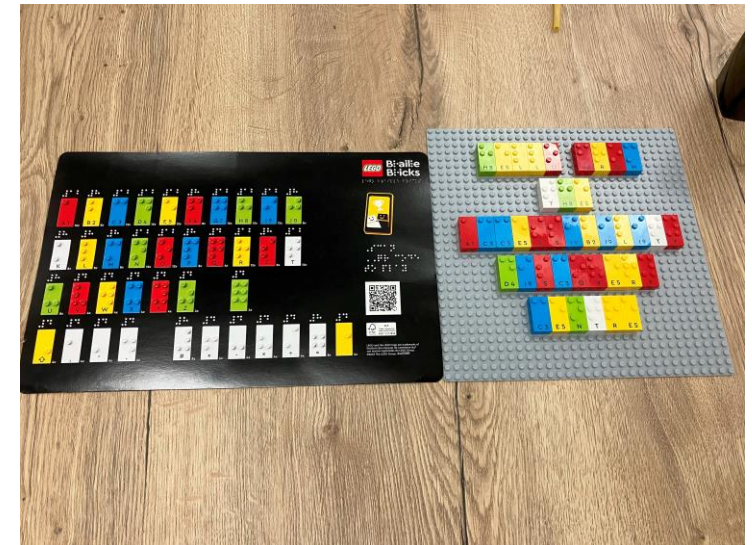

Audio screen readers e.g.

- JAWS, NVDA, MS Narrator, iOS Live Speech

Braille readers (e.g. Orbit 20)

- SD Card
- With compatible screen reader

Stuff: heady stuff !



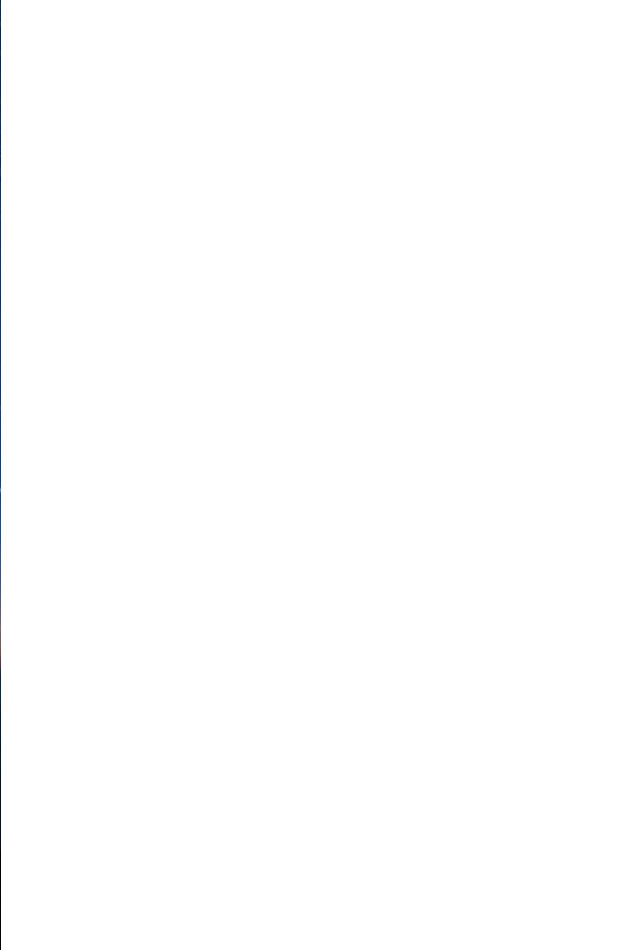
Player bangs the red control with their head.
